Phase 1 Assessment Interview

Two hour interview to determine extent to which a potential transitional pastor exhibits 15 characteristics. We request a letter of good standing from your conference minister.

Phase 3 Fieldwork (6 months)

Place to work at learning goals

Regular coaching contact

Write 3 critical incidents

Local contact
(emphasis on communication)
fitting into system
review learning goals
could review critical incidents
monthly contact
make sure they know what you
are doing in a congregation

Phase 4 - (Three day event)

Debrief

- utilize fieldwork learnings
- critical incidents

Deeper development of both
Development Tasks and
Process Tasks along with
explanation of tools for each.

issues emerging in critical
incident presentations.
