

Amigo Covid Guest Policy

Updated 12/16/2021

Thank you for coming to Amigo! We are happy you are here. Due to a severe storm we experienced Thursday, August 12, we have extensive damage to our site. Our trails are open – to be used with caution. There are still areas that are taped off – please be careful! Please call 269-651-2811 for assistance at any time.

ILLNESS

If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms please do not enter Amigo Buildings.

- Temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- Sore throat
- Cough (for campers with chronic cough due to allergies or asthma, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Difficulty breathing (for children with asthma, a change from their baseline breathing)
- Diarrhea or vomiting
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever

Please do not come to Amigo Centre if you are in quarantine due to exposure to an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

MASK REGULATIONS

Masks are **recommended** for all individuals in indoor settings.

- Guests at Amigo by themselves may choose to whether to wear masks when in their group inside.
- Guests from one household do not need to wear masks inside when not with other households.
- Guests must wear masks when around staff.
- Guests must wear masks when in the Dining Hall, except when eating.
- Masks are not required outside.
- Amigo Centre staff will continue to wear masks when serving guests or campers inside.

BEFORE COMING TO AMIGO

Additional guidelines per our preparedness and response plan:

- If someone develops symptoms they must return home immediately.
- If someone has been in close contact with a known case within the past 14 days they may not come.
- Contact information for each household is gathered, either through the church directory or while they are here for contact tracing needs.

WHILE AT AMIGO

Amigo Centre has put the following things in place to ensure your safety:

- Staff are monitoring their health every day and procedures are in place for any symptoms or possible exposures that might come up.
- Staff, while inside, will wear a mask.
- Cleaning procedures have been updated to ensure that they are in line with CDC guidelines and use EPA approved disinfectant, Array Neutral-Quaternary Disinfectant.
- High touch areas such as door knobs, light switches and handrails will be cleaned and disinfected.
- Some buildings like the nature center and gym are closed, unless arrangements are made prior to arrival.

While at Amigo Centre we ask guests do the following:

- Monitor your health. If you begin to experience symptoms or become aware of a potential exposure be prepared to leave Amigo Centre. (We are not prepared to be a quarantine site.)
- Provide Amigo Centre with contact information in case the need arises for contact tracing.

If you or anyone in your group becomes ill with Covid-19 while at Amigo or soon after you leave, please let us know as soon as possible so we can take the necessary precautions. Thank you for coming to Amigo! Our goal is to provide a safe, relaxing environment for each of our guests as well as our staff.
