

MICHIGAN COVID RULES

Amigo Centre

Effective April 19 through May 24, 2021

In the state of Michigan we have the following rules that must be followed. These are effectively laws and not just guidelines. Violations of these, if reported can result in the suspension of licenses to operate a certified kitchen, our campground and our summer camp programs.

Outdoor gatherings

- Non-residential venues, 300 or fewer persons are gathered.
- Masks must be worn if 6ft of physical distancing is not possible.

Indoor gatherings

- Are prohibited at non-residential venues, except where no more than 25 persons are gathered.
- Such gatherings should be held consistent with guidance issued by the Department of Health and Human Services
- Masks must be worn in areas where multiple households are represented.

BEFORE COMING TO AMIGO

Additional guidelines per our preparedness and response plan:

- Anyone experiencing symptoms does not come.
- If someone develops symptoms they must return home immediately.
- If someone has been in close contact with a known case within the past 14 days they may not come.
- Contact information for each household is gathered, either through the church directory or while they are here for contact tracing needs.
- Physical distancing is expected with those outside of each household.

WHILE AT AMIGO

Amigo Centre has put the following things in place to ensure your safety:

- Staff are monitoring their health every day and procedures are in place for any symptoms or possible exposures that might come up.
- Staff, while inside, will wear a mask.
- Cleaning procedures have been updated to ensure that they are in line with CDC guidelines and use EPA approved disinfectant, Array Neutral-Quaternary Disinfectant.
- High touch areas such as door knobs, light switches and handrails will be cleaned and disinfected.
- Some buildings like the nature center and gym are closed.

While at Amigo Centre we ask guests do the following:

- Monitor your health. If you begin to experience symptoms or become aware of a potential exposure be prepared to leave Amigo Centre. (We are not prepared to be a quarantine site.)
- Each designated family area has been assigned a color to make it clear which areas are for which family
- Do not enter another guest area.
- If interacting with a staff member or another guest indoors that you wear a mask and maintain six feet of space.
- If interacting with a staff member or another guest outdoors that you maintain social distancing.
- Please do not invite others to spend time at Amigo who are outside of your household. We are trying to limit how many people are at Amigo Centre at one time.
- Provide Amigo Centre with contact information in case the need arises for contact tracing.

What all comes with a reservation or stay at Amigo Centre?

- Access to a canoe, life jackets and paddles. A crash course in how to safely use them. (warm weather)
- You're welcome to fish if you have a Michigan fishing license. These can be purchased on line.
- All of the trails are open and available to use.
- A campfire ring. We have a limited number close to the Retreat Center. They'll be assigned on a first come first serve basis.
- Our Nature Center is not open but we will have bird, tree and other various identification books available for you to use. We've designed a number of scavenger hunts and out door activities that you will be able to do while you are here.
- Use if the swim area is open and available to guests at Amigo Centre.
- Activity Center – ask for availability.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION/QUESTIONS

- There are a number of other staff led activities such as a pontoon ride, a nature hike, an outdoor cooking class or archery that can be scheduled but would require an extra fee.
- Can we come with multiple families? Sure, we'd ask that you spend your time together outdoors and spread out. *Note restrictions from the state of Michigan.
- Can family or friends come up and spend the day with us? We'd ask that only those that are staying here at camp be here. We are limiting how many people are here at one time.
- Are you serving food? Yes, if we have enough guests to warrant meals (10 or more) we are providing meals. We also have "pack-out" options if you would like to cook over a fire. Ask when making your reservation.

What do I need to bring?

- Retreat Center rooms – all bedding and towels provided.
- West Shore Lodge – bring your own pillow, bedding, blankets and towels. Amigo will provide a bath mat and a fitted sheet for the beds.
- Food (refrigerator is available)
- Toiletries
- Bug spray
- Games
- Books
- Mugs or water bottles (we have coffee makers available for you as well as ice)

If you or anyone in your group becomes ill with Covid-19 while at Amigo or soon after you leave, please let us know as soon as possible so we can take the necessary precautions.

Thank you for coming to Amigo! Our goal is to provide a safe, relaxing environment for each of our guests as well as our staff.

DEPARTURE

- When you leave, we ask that you take the sheets off the beds that you use and lay them on a pile on the floor or place the sheets along with any towels used in the laundry bag provided for you.
- Please leave the mattress pads on the bed.
- Please leave your room key in your room or on the ledge by the front office window
- Please complete an evaluation for your stay (provided upon arrival).
